Vocational Outcome: Certificate IV in Hairdressing

Employment: Likely functions in the hairdressing industry for those who achieve this qualification may include employment as a highly skilled hairdresser, working as part of a salon team or coordinating a salon team, a technical advisor with a hairdressing products company or independently as a freelance session stylist. Functions at this level include the self-directed application of a broad range of knowledge and skills and the provision of technical leadership, training and support to colleagues and the business, as well as advanced customer service skills. A hairdresser at this level may provide specialist services, including haircutting, hair design, hair colouring and complex colour correction. Pathways for this qualification could lead to advanced supervisory and management skills.
